
City Pass Benefits

The income limit for having a city pass has changed. More people are eligible for a city pass. If you were previously just above the eligibility limit, we hereby advise you to check again with the municipality to see if you are eligible starting this year.

Having a city pass has other advantages besides reimbursing the voluntary parental contribution. The city pass is there to accommodate low-income families (so this lower limit has been adjusted). If you want to know what the benefits are and whether your child is eligible, take a look at the municipality's
