## Inputs en exits

Herewith once again the arrangements for entering and leaving the school. All children enter through the main entrance and then go directly to their classrooms or join the line to go upstairs (applies to grades 4-8).
After school, preschool children leave school through the emergency door adjacent to their plaza. The children may not leave until the teacher has seen the child's parent/guardian.
The children of grade 3 leave the school through the back of the school building. The rest of the children leave the school through the main entrance.

## School hours

The children can enter from 8:20 am. Class starts at 8:30. Also on behalf of the teachers a request that your child be at school in plenty of time for the class to start at 8:30. If children regularly arrive late they will miss the start and in addition the group that has already started with the teacher will be disturbed.

Starting this school year we will be more strict about this. At 8:30 the classroom
door will close. Your child will be on time if he/she is in the classroom before the 8:30 a.m. bell without a coat on. Children who are still busy with their coats will wait in the hallway until they are called inside. Children who enter at the time the bell has already rang should report to Master Wijnand and Master Kenneth. They will receive a card to take to the classroom which must be handed in to the teacher. The teacher then knows that the tardy report will be registered. Important: in case of repeated tardiness, parents will be contacted to discuss this. If the situation does not improve, compulsory education may be called in. No one wants that.

From 8:20 the door opens. Your child is most welcome by then. In the interest of your child and the class wu therefore want to ask you to ensure that your child is at school on time. Thanks in advance!

## Commencement talks

The purpose of these conversations is to get acquainted with each other and to start the year well and together. There is
also room here to coordinate expectations in terms of maintaining contact between you and the teacher.

In the week of September 18, the first starting conversations will take place at school. These conversations last about 10 minutes. You can think of it as a reverse ten-minute conversation where you as a parent/guardian are mainly talking. It is the intention that your child is also present during this conversation. During these ten minutes there is time to get acquainted and tell the teacher about your child. What does the teacher need to know about your child? What does your child like to do? What are your child's talents?

Starting Monday, September 11, you can register for the kick-off meeting with your child's teacher. This is done through the Social Schools app. You have one week, namely until Friday, September 15, 4 p.m., to register.

## Schoolfruit

Starting the first week of school, we will again be able to arrange fruit for three days for our children through school meals. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday there will be a piece of fruit for each student. On the other days it is nice if you can bring.


## Belangrijke info en data, Social Schools

Therefore, the recommendation is to download the app. Newsletters, messages from teachers and invitations and sign up for teacher interviews all go through this medium.
