Tests and resultinterviews

The past few weeks saw the testing period of CITO Leerling in Beeld for grades 3 through 7. Leerling in Beeld (LIB) is a student monitoring system. A student monitoring system is a program that gives teachers insight into the development of students. This is at the individual level, but also at the group and school level. We use this insight to best align the educational offerings with the educational needs of the students and the group. Learner in Focus is new to us and to the children. The
