What is the MR and what does it do?

Every school should have an MR (participation council). This consists of staff members and parents.

The MR should receive the school board's annual budget and policy plans so that it is aware of the main points of the educational policy and knows how the school is doing. The MR also has the right of consent on, among other things, the educational objectives of a school. This means that these objectives can only be set or changed with the consent of the MR.
