## Start taking tests

In January and February, we will be administering the national Leerling in Beeld tests to our pupils in grades 3 through 8. Starting next Monday, January 19, we will begin testing technical reading skills. Starting Wednesday, January 21, math, reading comprehension, and spelling will also be tested. You will receive the results from us shortly after the spring break. After the spring break, there will also be an opportunity to discuss your child's progress with the teacher.

It is important that our children are able to take these tests without pressure. These tests are a tool for us to obtain objective data. The results are analyzed and help us to see how we are doing and where we may need to make adjustments. We are


particularly interested in what they are already able to do without our help and where they will need extra support and practice in the coming period.

It also helps if the children are well rested and arrive at school on time so that they can concentrate properly and show what they have already mastered.

## Week of parent drop-in

In The week of Monday, February 9, is the second parent drop-in session for groups 3 through 8. This means that you, as parents, can experience the start of the day. Depending on the teacher, this will be the first 15 to 30 minutes of the day. You can then view your child's work, read together, or participate in an activity led by the teacher.
