Over the past few weeks, the CITO Leerling in Beeld (LIB) assessment period took place for grades 3 through 7. Leerling in Beeld (LIB) is a pupil monitoring system. A pupil monitoring system is a program that gives teachers insight into the development of their pupils. This insight is provided at an individual level, but also at a group and school level. We use this insight to tailor our educational provision as closely as possible to the educational needs of the pupils and the group.
