Information schoolyear 26-27

We are already busy preparing for the coming school year. For the coming school year, we will be starting with the following classes:

- Three kindergarten classes
- Two 3rd-grade classes
- One 4th-grade class
- Two 5th-grade classes
- One 6th-grade class
- One 7th-grade class
- One 8th-grade class

At our school, we strive to keep third-grade classes as small as possible and avoid starting with a single large class. This allows us to provide students with optimal guidance as they learn the essential foundational skills in reading, writing, and arithmetic. This intensive support is crucial at this stage of their development. At the same time, we must face the reality of the current teacher shortage and the available financial resources. As a result, it is not feasible to maintain small class sizes in all grade levels. One possible solution could be to form combined-grade classes. However, we have made a conscious decision to avoid this as much as possible, because combined-grade classes present

various organizational and educational challenges. To ensure that all students in 4th grade continue to receive the guidance they need, appropriate support will be provided to the teacher. This way, we can continue to provide a quality education to all our students. If you have any questions about this, please feel free to stop by the administration office for further clarification.

I hope to let you know soon which teachers will be assigned to the classes.

We also have some good news: we've been able to hire two new colleagues for the coming school year—Ms. Elise, who will teach one of the two fifth-grade classes, and Ms. Annette, who will work in the preschool program. Below, they introduce themselves to you:
