On **Tuesday evening, August 25**, is our general parents' evening. We think it is very important that you are well informed about what we do at school and what you can help your child with. What are the points of attention for that year and what can you possibly do at home? We will inform you about this this evening. We have deliberately planned the parents' evening early in the year so that we can get off to a good start together with you. Two weeks later are the initial interviews. These are also important, but then you as a parent are mainly talking. More information about this will follow in the second newsletter of 28 August.

Schoolfruit en Tommy Tomato

From the first week of school we can again use school meals for three days

arrange fruit for our children. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday there is a piece of fruit for each student. On the other days it is nice if you can give fruit/vegetables.



On Wednesdays there is a healthy and hot lunch for all the children of Tommy Tomato. The children do not have to bring food during the break halfway through the day. Before ten o'clock it is nice if the children get something to eat.

Inputs and outputs

Here are the agreements about entering and leaving the school.

All children enter through the main entrance and then go directly to their classroom or join the queue to go upstairs (applies to groups 4 to 8).

After school, the children of the toddlers leave the school through the emergency door adjacent to their square. The children are not allowed to leave until the teacher has seen the child's parent/guardian.

The children of group 3 leave the school through the back of the school building.

The rest of the children leave the school through the main entrance.

Parent meeting: coffee with management

During the school year, various parent meetings are organized. The first meeting will take place on Wednesday 25 August at which the director will be present. The Parent Child advisor will also be present and other members of the Parent Child Team and Helena. This morning all kinds of questions can be asked about school, but there may also be topics that you as a parent/guardian would like to know more about. We can then schedule this at another parent meeting.



School hours

The door opens at 8.20 am. Your child is already very welcome! In the interest of your child and the class, we would therefore like to ask you to ensure that your child is at school well in advance.

The children can enter from 8.20 am. **The lesson starts at 8.30 am.** Also on behalf of the teachers the request to ensure that your child is at school well in time so that the lesson can start at 8.30 am. If children regularly come in late, they miss the start of the lesson and the group that has already started the lesson is disturbed with the teacher.

The class door closes at 8.30 am. **Your child will be on time if he/she is present in the classroom without a coat on before the 8.30 a.m. bell.** Children who come in when the bell has already rung or after the bell has rung must report to Miss Rebecca and Master Kenneth. They receive a card to take to the classroom that must be handed in to the teacher. The teacher then knows that the late report will be registered. Important: in case of repeated lateness, the parents will be contacted to discuss this. If the situation does not improve, it is possible that Compulsory Education will be called in.

Lessons start at **8.30 am.**



School is out at **2.15 pm.**



Important info and dates, Social Schools

In the Social Schools app you can find important dates, such as holidays, study days (then the children are free) and half days of lessons (bottom right under 'agenda'). These were shared with you at the end of last school year.

In the newsletters you can find the most important information for the coming weeks, until the next newsletter, under the first heading 'Agenda'.



It is important that you can be easily reached through Social Schools. The advice is therefore to download the app. Newsletters, messages from the teachers and invitations and signing up for conversations with the teacher all go through this medium. If you have difficulty with this, you can visit the school and we will help you with this.
