Storing Ziggo

Looking back at the general parents' evening

Last Tuesday evening was the parents' evening. How nice that so many parents were able to attend! This way you have a good idea of what your child will be doing this year at school. In addition, you also know what you can do with your child at home. What is very good and important for all children is reading books. By reading a lot, your child develops in many areas. Their vocabulary is expanding. They learn to concentrate and empathize with someone else for a longer period of time. It also stimulates your child's imagination and thinking skills, which promotes creativity. When children can read well, it also helps them enormously in all school subjects.



Week of the initial interviews

The purpose of these conversations is to get to know each other and to start the year well and together. There is also room here to align expectations in terms of maintaining contact between you and the teacher.

In the week of September 7, the initial interviews will take place at school. These conversations last about 10 minutes. You can see it as a reverse ten-minute conversation in which you as a parent/guardian mainly speak. **It is the**

intention that your child is also present at this conversation.

During these ten minutes there is time to get to know each other and tell the teacher about your child. What does the teacher need to know about your child?
What does your child like to do?
What are your child's talents?

From Monday 31 August you can register for the initial interview with your child's teacher. This is done via the Social Schools app. You have one week, namely until Friday 4 September 16.00 hours, to register.
